We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

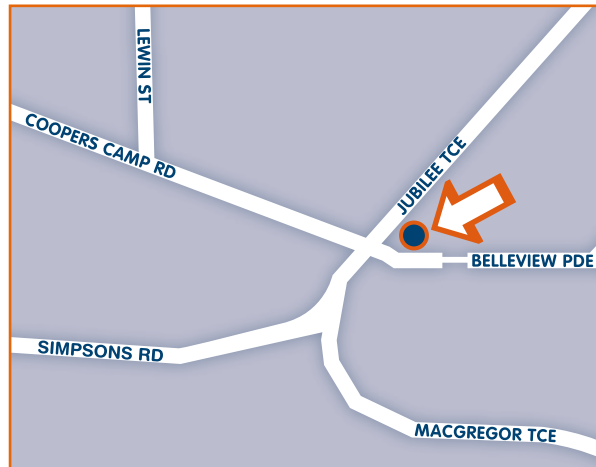

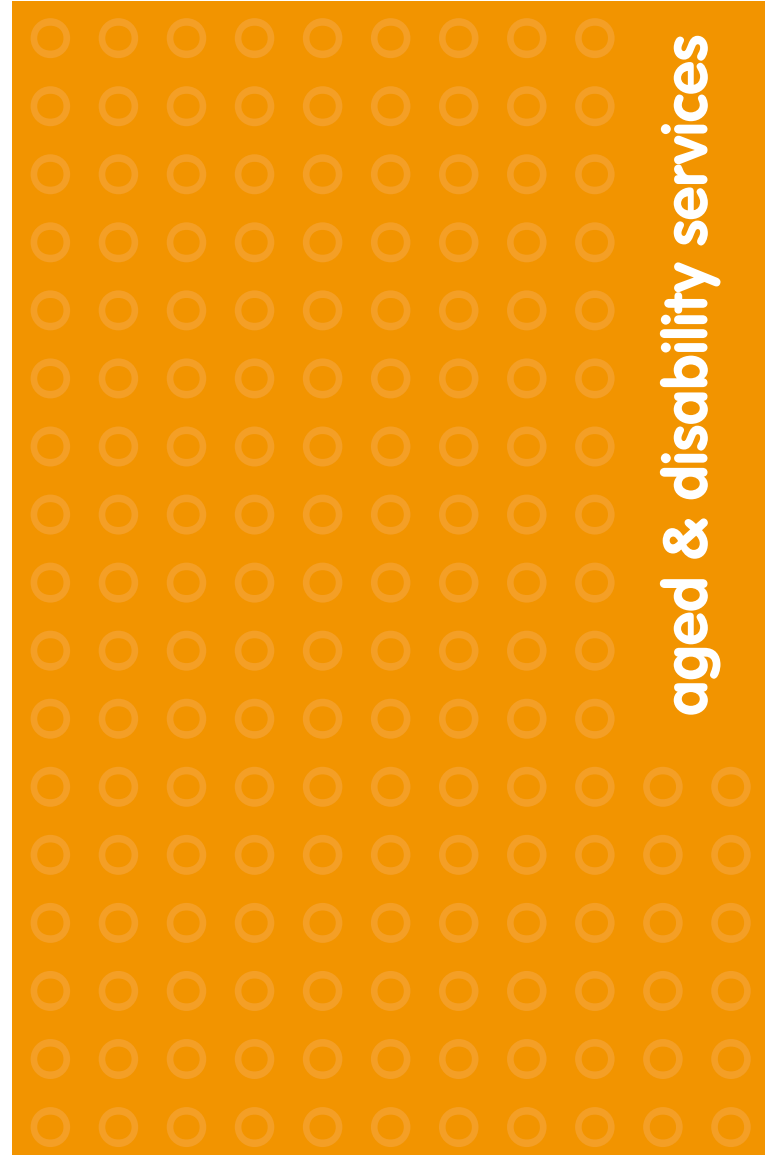

AGED & DISABILITY SERVICES

Community offers a range of services that support frail aged, people with a disability and their carers, enabling them to remain living independently and connected to their community. Staff and volunteers are matched to clients' needs to provide them with regular social interaction and assistance with activities of daily living.

What do we offer?

We offer services and support in response to individual client needs, matching a suitable volunteer or staff member to provide the required assistance.

We are able to assist with:

- shopping trips
- providing transport for medical and other appointments
- accessing transport options
- escorting you on social outings and activities within the community
- lifestyle and household support
- domestic assistance (superannuants)
- information and referral

Who is eligible?

Community's Aged and Disability Services are available to anyone who is frail aged, people with disabilities or their carers living in Paddington, Red Hill, Bardon, Rainworth, Milton, Toowong or The Gap.

How much will it cost?

This program is funded by Commonwealth and State Governments through their Home and Community Care Services.
