We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

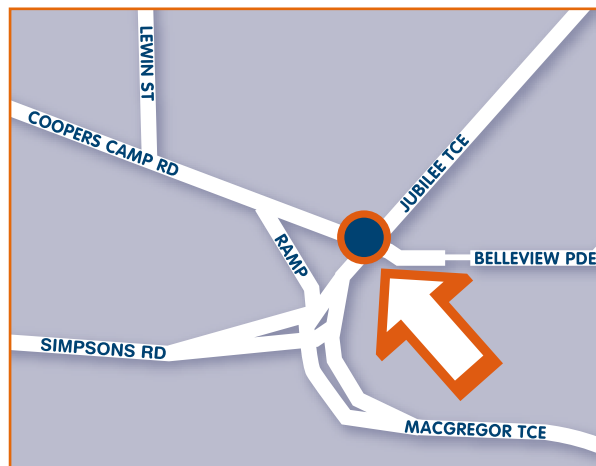

## COMMUNITY EDUCATION

The aim of our community education program is to provide learning opportunities for members of our community, in a cooperative and nurturing environment.

Participants are given the opportunity to develop skills, establish networks, gain support and gather information that will enhance the quality of their lives.

### What do we offer?

We offer a program of learning and leisure, providing activities across a wide range of interest areas including health and fitness, art and creativity, parenting and family support.

Our community education programs are delivered in formal and informal learning environments to suit all levels of participants. Activities are structured into seminars, short courses, workshops, discussions, and self help groups.

We recruit a team of well-equipped tutors who are passionate about sharing their skills, knowledge and enthusiasm within a community-based setting. We welcome new facilitators and ideas to the program.

Communify also offers a number of venues for hire.

### Who is eligible for this service?

Community education programs are available to anyone with an interest in learning for leisure. There are no specific entry or age requirements for Communify courses. We are keen to hear new ideas for future activities and welcome expressions of interest from potential facilitators.
