We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

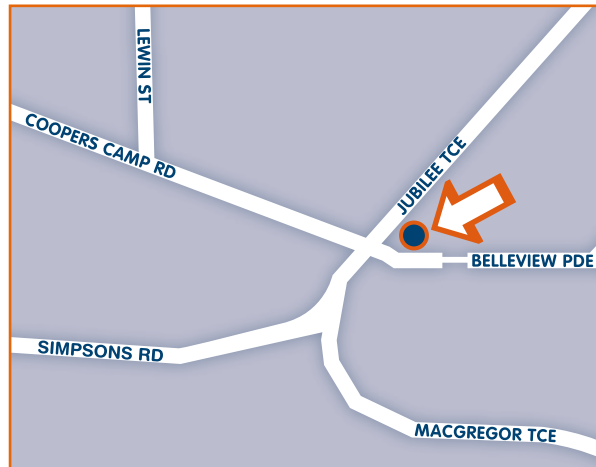

## FAMILY AND INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Community's Family and Individual Support service helps people to cope with difficult and stressful life experiences by providing information, counselling and advocacy. We focus on strengthening and supporting people according to their individual needs, by developing a network of community support, referral and self-help services with an emphasis on prevention and education.

### What do we offer?

At some point in their lives most people face significant challenges and life-changing experiences. We can provide assistance to individuals and families experiencing social isolation, economic hardship or emotional crises.

On accessing the service you will be supported by the Family Support Worker, who can help identify your needs and assist you to find support services in your local community.

### Who is eligible for this service?

The service is open to anyone living in the Inner North and Inner Western suburbs. Individuals, families or other service providers can access the service by contacting the Family Support Worker.

### The service includes:

- information and referral
- parenting and relationship advice
- assistance with household and financial management
- crisis counselling
- housing options and information
- self help, community education and support groups
- emergency relief services including:
  - food vouchers
  - no interest loans
  - Christmas food and toy drive

### How much will it cost?

This is a free and confidential service funded by Department of Communities through their Community Support Program.
