We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

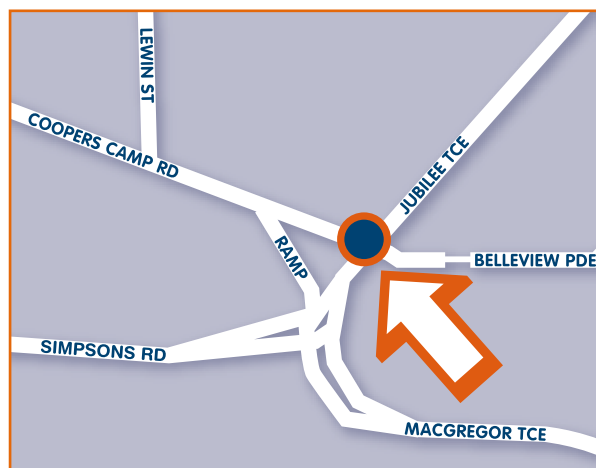

VENUES FOR HIRE

Community has a range of community venues available for hire. These include meeting rooms, halls and private rooms suitable for counselling, community meetings, conferences and functions. Venues may be hired by any interested group and can be used for both commercial and community purposes.

How much will it cost?

Costing is structured to ensure that all members of the community are able to access these facilities.

Rates vary depending on the venue and specific requirements. Reduced rates can be arranged for full day hire and we offer a discount to not-for-profit organisations.

Clients may choose to have the Cleaning Fee waived, by ensuring the venues are left in a clean and tidy state.

What do we offer?

Our venues are well maintained, clean and comfortable, providing the perfect location for small group meetings or larger functions.

Most venues are wheelchair accessible and offer off street parking, with a wide range of facilities available including white boards, tables and chairs, air conditioning and kitchen facilities.

Our facilities include:

Bardon Hall, 247 Simpsons Rd, Bardon

- Set back from the roadway, the hall is fully fenced with a small stage and wheelchair access. Suitable for groups with children, wanting a safe venue.

Ithaca Hall, Cnr Kennedy and Enoggera Tce,

Red Hill - Formerly Ithaca Library, this historic building is now used by the community for meetings and leisure/learning activities.

Jubilee Hall, 180 Jubilee Terrace, Bardon

- Features an airy north-easterly aspect, plenty of natural light, a solid wooden, polished floor, and a stage.

Meeting Place, 180 Jubilee Terrace, Bardon

- Suitable for small groups of up to 15 people, or one-on-one counselling.

The Cottage, 300 Waterworks Rd, Ashgrove

- This renovated Queenslander has multi-purpose rooms suitable for private counselling or medium sized groups.

The Basement, 180 Jubilee Terrace, Bardon

- A perfect venue for workshops, meetings and training (evenings only). Suitable for groups of up to 20 people.
