We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

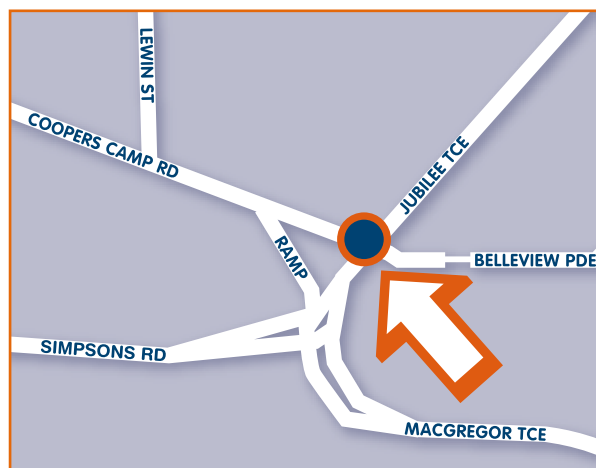
