We offer emergency assistance to assist people through financial difficulties. Community can provide financial assistance, advice, counseling, or referrals.

THE PANTRY

The Pantry operates twice a week and is staffed, maintained and supported by volunteers associated with the Inner Western Suburbs Inter Church Council, the Bardon Fellowship, the Paddington Red Hill Rotary Club and the community.

What do we offer?

- Food vouchers
- Preserved food and frozen meals

- Fruit and vegetables

We also offer support and counseling, and can refer you to a Social Worker when they are on the premises (or by appointment).

Who is eligible?

Applicants need to:

- be receiving a government pension or payment;
- live in the Inner North/North Western suburbs.

How much will it cost?

This is a free and confidential service funded by the Commonwealth and State Governments. Any donations of preserved, canned and frozen foods are welcome and greatly appreciated.

The Pantry is open on Mondays and Thursdays from 12 noon to 2 pm.
